## Castello di Romitorio

Castello Romitorio winery takes its name from the enormous twelfth-century fortress that sits atop a hill surrounded by a thick oak forest in North-western Montalcino. Abandoned in the 1950's, its rebirth as a winery occurred in 1984 when the current owner Filippo Chia's father Artist Sandro Chia acquired the estate from his friend, Baron Giorgio Franchetti. The first parcels of Sangiovese were planted in 1984 on the slopes adjacent to the Castello Romitorio using the most modern machinery to ensure that the vineyards would grow deep root stock able to soak up all of the micro minerals. In 1995 the winery expanded with the acquisition of 'Poggio di Sopra' in the South-east region of Montalcino, near the Romanic abbey of Castelnuovo dell'Abate, an area known for its warm climate and production of grapes with exceptional structure. In 2006 the winery broke ground by building a new state-of-the-art underground cellar which was finally completed in 2007.

## The story behind the (beautiful) labels



Born in Florence in 1946, Sandro Chia was known as a principal advocate of the Italian “Transavanguardia” movement. This art movement responded to the explosion of conceptual art, which found many mediums of expression and reintroduced emotion back into drawing, painting and sculpture. Transavantgarde marked a return to figurative art & symbolism, as well as mythic imagery, which was rediscovered during the height of the movement. This style is seen very prominently in the labels of the Romitorio wines as they reflect an abstract form of passion, which is his expression of the wine.
