Domaine Jean-Baptiste Boudier

Domaine Jean-Baptiste Boudier is a new domaine having undertaken their first vintage in 2015. This came from just 3 hectares.

Jean-Baptiste worked alongside his father until 2014 in his father's 7 hectare domaine and during the vinification process they realised that they had different visions of wine, leading to their mutual decision of Jean-Baptiste experimenting on his own.

Domaine Jean-Baptiste Boudier is not certified organic, but practising. His production is small with 5 barrels for his largest cuvée. He destems for his reds and vinification is in stainless steel with indigenous yeasts and very low added sulphur. For his whites, whole bunches are gently pressed and fermentation starts in stainless steel and finishes in the barrel, again with very low added sulphur.

His wines have a very welcome freshness from the cooler terroir with great fruit and balance.

Read a little more below about these wines which we are thrilled to welcome to our range. We will have the 2020 wines at our En Primeur Tasting in January including some other cuvées.

Jean-Baptiste Boudier Savigny-Les-Beaune Rouge Ez Connardises 2017



This wine comes from a 0.17 hectare site with the vines between 15-20 years of age. Soils are of clay and limestone with alluvial stone deposits. The grapes are destemmed and undergo indigenous yeast fermentation before ageing for 14 months in barrel.

Jean-Baptiste Boudier Aloxe-Corton Blanc Les Combes 2019



From vines planted in 1942, four barrels made including one new, bottled in October. A little more yellow in the colour. Fuller bodied nose then reined in by a little reduction. Sound solid white, fuller bodied but less flair, an interesting saline touch at the end. Avoids too yellow a fruit.

Jasper Morris Inside Burgundy Tasted: January 2021

Jean-Baptiste Boudier Corton-Charlemagne 2019



These vines are a lot older - 60 years on average. The site sits just under the woods of Corton, East facing. Whole clusters are pressed slowly and gently with indigenous yeast fermentation taking place before being aged in the barrel for 20 months.

Jean-Baptiste Boudier Pernand-Vergelesses Blanc 2019



The only blended wine in 2019, coming from Vignes Blanches, Les Pins and Devant les Cloux. The wine was matured with 15% new wood and bottled in July. It shows a very light reduction with excellent energy behind, quite floral, a small touch of yellow fruit, very good length, a little cream at the back. No more than 13.5%. Delicious, almost from now on.
