

Weingut Veyder-Malberg, Austria, Wachau



We are proud to be able to offer the much sought-after wines from Weingut Veyder-Malberg, one of the truly great Austrian winemakers.

These wines are extremely limited, less than one thousand cases are produced on this 4-hectare site per year, and this mixed 6 bottle case offer is a great opportunity to try a wide selection of wines that you will not find anywhere else in the UK at this price.

Weingut Veyder-Malberg is based in Wachau, the most prestigious winegrowing region in the country. Most of the vineyards are located in the coldest part on the far Western end of the Wachau. The extreme slopes and terraced sites are part of the UNESCO World Heritage where warm Pannonian and cool Atlantic and Alpine winds collide, creating extreme climatic influences.

The ancient gravel soil provides a great environment for Riesling to thrive while Grüner Veltliner is planted on the lower slopes where the soil is composed of löss mixed with river sand and alluvium. The average age of the vines is 30-50 years old.

A dedicated biodynamic grower, for Peter, the key to happier soil, healthy vines and better quality grapes is all about creating a good environment for microorganisms.

The farming and harvest are done by hand, and most of the grapes go through long and cold maceration followed by spontaneous fermentation with a minimal amount of added sulphur and sometimes none.

Dependant on style and the location of the vineyard, the wines are aged in stainless steel or old wooden casks and maturation times varies between 5 to 15 months.

The Wines



Veyder-Malberg Wachauer 2B Riesling

Grapes hand harvested and blended from two sites, Bruck (highest in Wachau) and Buschenberger. Rieslings here develop a distinctive fruitiness with spicy notes. Concentrated fragrant nose with rose, quince and white fruits, with hint of tropical fruit and light petrol notes. Piquant and elegant palate, fresh fruits and lingering minerality with easy but lengthy finish. 12.3% vol and 2.9g/l RS. Pairs well with white fish, crab and poultry.



Veyder-Malberg Wachauer Liebedich Gruner Veltliner

This is a creamy white wine that has aromas of pear and green apple, melon with notes of white pepper and touches of white chocolate on the nose. On the palate it is very juicy and well-balanced. alcohol 11.7% vol., dry at 2.5g/l RZ, 5.5g/l acidity, pH 3.2



Veyder-Malberg Elsarner Brandstätt Riesling

Brandstätt age-old terraced vineyard, around 450m above sea level with mica slate soil. Rieslings develop a unique fruitiness with spicy notes and a delicate minerality, express more of terroir and old wine making tradition than grape variety. Aged in local acacia barrels. Ripe peach and pear, honeydew melon and hint of yellow plum on nose, juicy palate with ripe tropical fruits and great acid structure. 12.6% vol, Dry, with 1.7g/l RS. Pairs well with juicy white fish.



Veyder-Malberg Weissenkirchen Weitenberg Gruner Veltiner

Vinyard with the oldest vines, more than 60yo, northwest of Weissenkirchen. Small yields and small grapes, fermented and matured in 4yo 800L oak cask. Clear and flinty-scented nose with ripe pear and nectarine. Full bodied and lush palate with ripe stone fruits and pear, honey, hint of herbal notes with very long mineral finish. 2016: 13.2% vol, dry with 1.1g/l 2017: alcohol 13.9% vol, dry at 1.2g/l RZ, 5.6g/l. Pairs well with white meat and shellfish.



Veyder-Malberg Viesslinger Bruck Riesling

Although the "Bruck" location is considered the best and warmest in Viessling, it is nevertheless one of the coolest, because it is also the highest in the Wachau. Viessling can be seen as a counterpoint to the much warmer terroir of the eastern Wachau. My Rieslings here develop a unique fruitiness with spicy notes and a filigree minerality. The vineyard is cultivated purely by hand without a tractor. alcohol 12.3% vol, dry at 1.4g/l RZ, 8.6g/l acidity, pH 3.2
